

## General Campground Policies

- Quiet hours at all Camp Nawakwa facilities span from 10:00pm – 7:00am. During this time Rental Groups must keep loud activities inside and should not exceed the volume of regular speaking voices outside.
- ATVs/UTVs/Motorized Bikes/ Snowmobiles or any other recreational vehicles are strictly forbidden for use on Camp Nawakwa property. The above may be utilized on a case-by-case basis for maintenance and/or mobility needs only with prior written approval from the Registrar.
- Large appliances (e.g., air conditioners, refrigerators) are not allowed in the cabins. Violations may result in a utility surcharge on your account.
- Park in designated spaces only. Please do not park your vehicle or otherwise occupy a site not under your reservation.
- Making use of camp sites, cabins, or other non-common areas not under your reservation may result in additional fees.
- In case of severe weather, seek shelter in the Hobbs basement, MEM basement, or Timbercrest Latrine. See **Emergency Procedures** section for more information.
- Fireworks are prohibited, including sparklers, smoke bombs, and firecrackers.
- Tents must be agreed upon with the Registrar or Camp Host prior to rental date(s).
- The total number of guests staying in any provided lodging may not exceed the maximum capacity of that lodging.
- Any outstanding debt owed to Our Nawakwa, Inc. may result in the loss of the use of Camp Nawakwa facilities.
- No one previously convicted of a violent and/or sexual crime against children will be allowed to rent, supervise activities on, or utilize Camp Nawakwa property.
- Firearms/Hunting: Hunting and the use of any firearms is prohibited on the entire property.
- Activities that could damage the property or its facilities, harm the natural beauty of the site, or disturb others are strictly prohibited.
- All provided items (kitchen items, mattresses, furniture, cots, etc.) must be left in their original condition and location.
- Rental Groups are responsible for their own snow removal & ice-melt spreading at the entrances to the unit(s) which they are using. Our Nawakwa, Inc. will provide shovels and ice melt.
- Rental Groups of Camp Nawakwa are solely responsible for any damage or injury caused by themselves, their children, or their pets.
- Our Nawakwa, Inc. may not be held responsible for personal injuries or damage, loss, or theft of any personal property.
